

My work is informed by the anthropological study of the architecture of industries; energy, agriculture, automotive, and manufacturing. Acting as author and architect, I endeavor to uncover and expose the cultural, societal, and familial weight inherited by the coming generations.

Bio

Dustin Farnsworth has gained national recognition for his complex and intricate sculptures, captivating audiences through a mastery of craft, material, and storytelling. His architectures appear convincingly as found relics while his carving elicits a visceral and empathetic response. From references to historical ceremonial headdresses to post-industrial architecture and detritus, each sculpture embodies the trademarks of his practice. Farnsworth's works expertly illustrate the inherited weight on a young generation.

Farnsworth's diligence and determination is evident from his portfolio and resume. Since his graduation from Kendall College of Art and design in 2010, he has participated in over 40 exhibitions nationally, two solo exhibitions, and forthcoming solo exhibitions at the Cameron Art Museum in Wilmington, North Carolina and The Huntsville Museum of Art in Huntsville, Alabama. His talent has been recognized nationally as a recipient of the prestigious Windgate Fellowship Grant upon graduating in 2010 as well as receiving a North Carolina Arts Council Fellowship Grant in 2014. Farnsworth has been an Arist-In-Residence at Arrowmont School of Arts and Crafts, a Resident Artist at Penland School of Crafts, and a Windgate Fellowship Artist in Residence and Honorary Fellow at the University of Wisconsin Madison.
